

# Guidelines for the Graduation Portfolio

## M.Ed. in Media, Instructional Technology Concentration

All M.Ed. students in Instructional Technology are required to submit an electronic portfolio at least one month before graduation. An e-portfolio is a collection of work used to illustrate competency or mastery in some defined area of knowledge and/or set of skills. It also provides a means for reflection on personal and professional development.

### Required Elements

1. Introduction
2. Resume
3. Standards/Artifacts/Reflection
